Robert A. Schreiber was an Associate Professor of Biochemistry at the University of TN Center for the Health Sciences from 1974 through 1985. He was President of the Memphis chapter of the Society for Neuroscience, and President of Sigma Xi, the Society for Scientific Research.

He then became a Financial Advisor in 1986, specializing in retirement planning. He won the Memphis Magazine Investment Contest in 1997 and 1998, and has recently been selected as a "5-Star Financial Advisor" in 2008. He also has just been chosen for inclusion in Strathmore's Who's Who.

He taught a course in Future Trends in Biology in the Extension Division of Rhodes College in 1989, and did an extensive section on the environment. He and the others in the class realized that we were talking about our children and grandchildren, and became so perturbed that they formed an all-volunteer nonprofit group for environmental education, CommonSense, Inc., which started the recycling movement in Memphis, promoted the EPA's Green Lights Program for lighting and energy efficiency, started the ad-hoc Committee for the Environment at City Council, helped start numbers of environmental clubs, and has given any number of lectures on the carbon cycle and its implications throughout Memphis and Shelby County. He also helped create another 501c3, Greater Memphis Greenline, which is devoted to develop an integrated hiking/biking trails system throughout Memphis and Shelby County. He is presently President of the Board of Directors.
